# Columbia Basin Video Festival in the Tri-Cities, Washington

## Rules:

There are 2 categories: **"Short Video Contest"** and **"1-Minute or Less Video Contest"** for **Adult** or **Student** (*age 21 and younger*). The Columbia Basin Video Festival is looking for **videos suitable for family audiences. Be creative.** Submit a copy of the video in one of the following formats: Mini-DV, DVCAM, VHS, S-VHS, DVD, or on a CD in the following NTSC-DV formats: Digital Video or Quicktime. **Entries will not be returned.**

### "Short Video Contest" (10-minute limit)

**Entry Fee is \$20.00** for each video that is submitted.

Submitted videos for the "Short Video Contest" must not exceed 10 minutes (this includes the introduction and credits). **Videos over 10 minutes will not be accepted.**

Along with mailing in your entry we welcome the donation of any simple prop or item used in your video to be submitted as a door prize at the CBVF. It doesn't have to be expensive. You are under no obligation to do so. Please email any questions you may have to Wanda Mar at: [Wanda.Mar@pnl.gov](mailto:Wanda.Mar@pnl.gov).

Separate from your entry include a 1-minute video bio about yourself and your motivations for creating your video.

### 1-Minute or Less Video Contest:

**Entry Fee is \$10.00** for each video that is submitted.

Shoot a video that is 1 minute or less on any subject matter. Some sample ideas: clips with music, using just photographs, special effects samples, parodies, abstract images, experimental, a very short story, a fake commercial, or whatever you can think of.

Please include a 1-minute video bio about yourself and your motivations for creating your video entry.

## Eligibility:

Everyone is invited to participate: **Amateur or Professional.** The Battelle Video Club is looking for original productions. Submissions prepared for hire or as a regular part of your job employment **will NOT be considered.** Entries submitted to a prior CBVF event will also not be considered. The Battelle Video Club reserves the right to reject any entries deemed inappropriate for family viewing at the Columbia Basin Video Festival.

## Deadline:

Entries must be postmarked no later than **April 30, 2005.**

## Prizes and Awards:

To be presented at the screening scheduled for June 2005.
